

Sample Letter for COVID-19 Related Pet Protection

I am sending this letter to inform you that I have a pet in my rental unit, whose presence began before February 1, 2023, and was necessitated by COVID-19.

On January 23, 2024, the Los Angeles City Council approved an amendment, extending eviction protections for tenants with pets (see Ordinance No. 188108).

This amendment requires landlords and building managers to allow any companion animal residing in a rental dwelling unit, whose presence began before February 1, 2023 and was necessitated and related to COVID-19, pursuant LAMC Section 49.99.2, to continue residing in the tenant's unit for the duration of the animal's natural life, or until the tenant either voluntarily relocates the animal or voluntarily vacates the premises – regardless of whether there is any term in the rental agreement or lease that prohibits the presence of unauthorized pets.

I seek to comply with the forementioned code and am open to communication.
